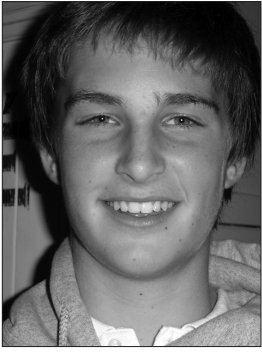


2007 GAME EVENT INTERNS



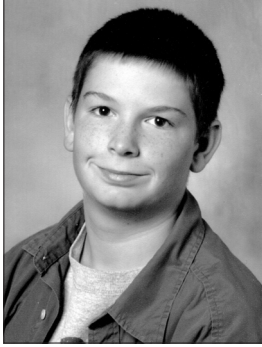
Blake Blaze

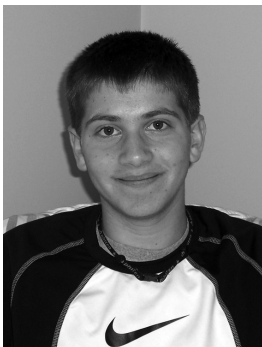
Kristen Logan

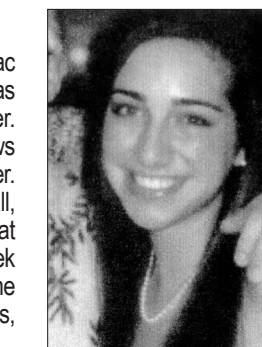
Lauren Wickel
